



A Draught of a Tract of Land called the Chest Farm being part of a larger Tract of the same name situate on the Westward Branch of the Chest Creek about a mile above the second Forks of the said Creek & About six or seven Miles above where the old Trading Path leading from Frankstown to the Kittanning crosses the said Creek adjoining Land Surveyed for Daniel Robinson Gabez Maud Fisher and Land Surveyed on the behalf of Samuel Pleasants in the County of Bedford Containing three hundred and twenty four Acres and thirty seven Perches and the usual Allowance of six Percent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 17<sup>th</sup> Day of June 1775 for John Elmsley in pursuance of a Warrant granted to him Dated the 27<sup>th</sup> Day of April in the same year by
