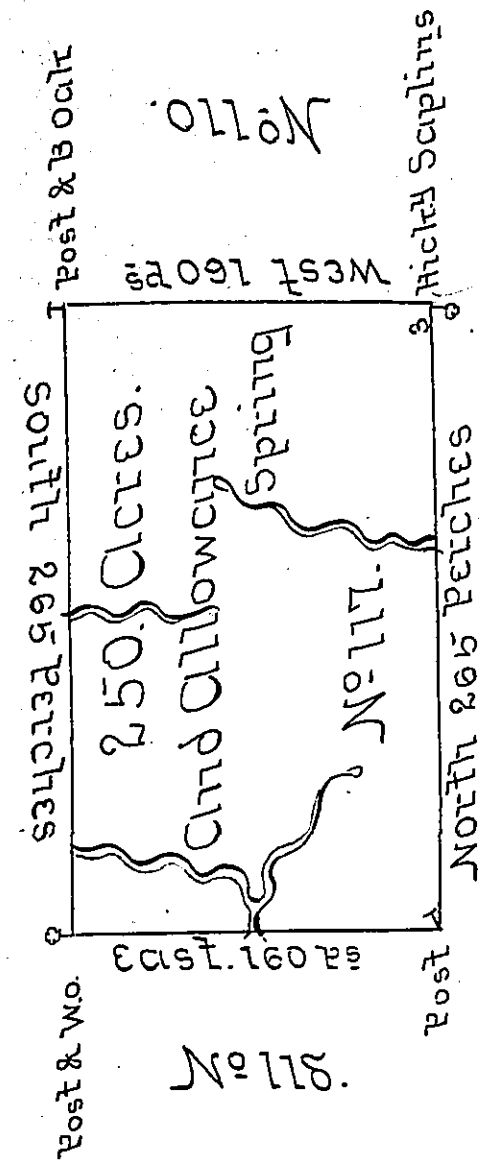

In Pursuance of an Act of Assembly passed the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1763 for the sale of certain lands therein mentioned and by virtue of a Commission Under the hand and seal of Office of John Dikens Esq<sup>r</sup> Surveyor General for the State of Pennsylvania bearing date at Philadelphia the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of August 1763 The above Tract of land containing two hundred and fifty Acres and Allowance of 6% Cent for Roads &c. Was surveyed on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of July 1765 by
