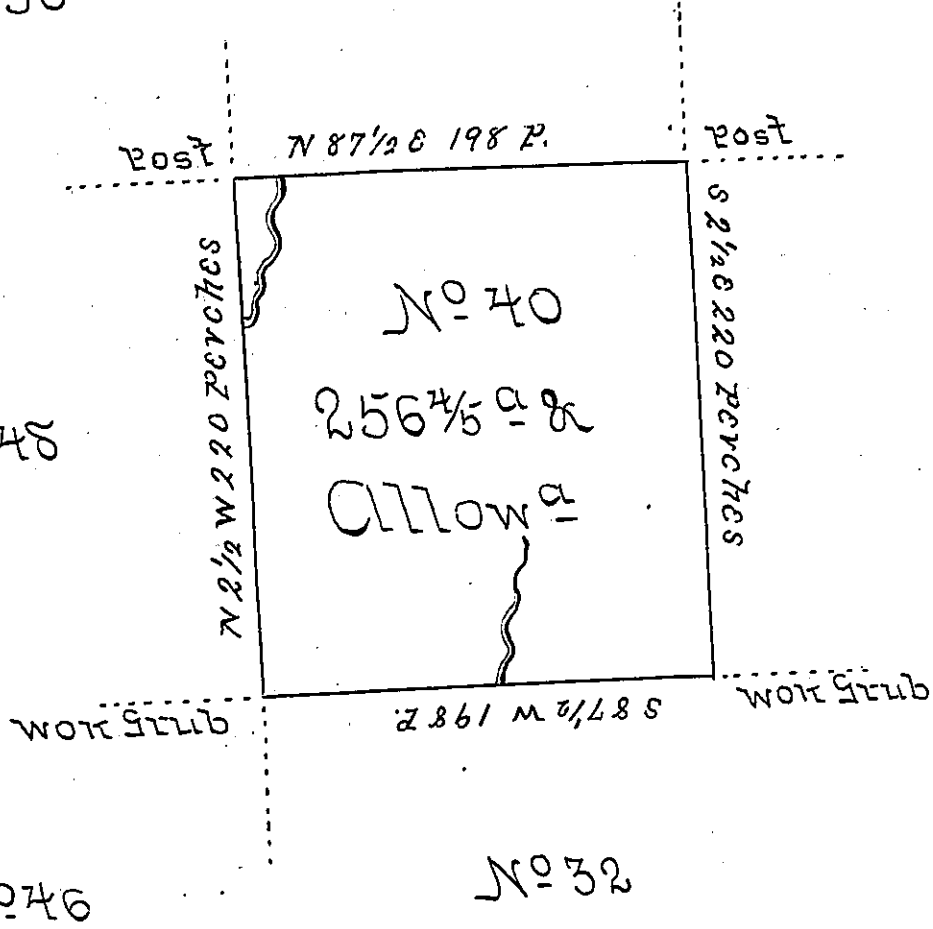

By virtue of a law passed the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1785 entitled an Act for the sale of certain lands for the purpose of redeeming & paying off the Certificates of Depreciation given to the Officers & Soldiers of the Pennsylvania line & c.
