



Situate on the west side of French Creek in Allegheny County containing 401 Acres 150 ps and allowance of Six pr Cent for Roads &c. Resurveyed the 12<sup>th</sup> day of July 1799. In pursuance of a Warrant of 400<sup>a</sup> granted to Robert Erwin Bearing date the 30<sup>th</sup> day of May 1792. It being the same tract of land which was Surveyed the 6<sup>th</sup> day of November 1794 for William Jones on his Improvement dated the 5<sup>th</sup> day of November 1794.
