

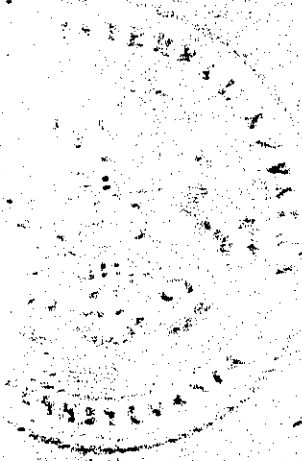
The above is a Draught of a Survey made the 27th of April 1818 in pursuance of a warrant granted to James Ewart bearing date March 13th 1818. containing 89 1/2 Acres and allowance of 6 per cent for roads &c. Situate - Morris township Greene County on the waters of Bates fork of ten mile Creek.
