Being part of a larger tract of 234 1/2 acres & allowance. Originally Surveyed by George Stevenson Esqr. late U.S. on the 24th day of April A.D. 1758. in pursuance of a Warrant for 50^{ac} granted to William Ewing, dated the 14th day of March A.D. 1755. The above part resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract on the 6th day of September 1786. and now at the request of Michael Wilt the present owner of said part the same is examined. Corrected and returned for confirmation - February 16th 1822.
