



In pursuance of a Warrant for 400 acres dated the tenth day of April 1793 granted to Luke Elly was Surveyed on the fifth day of June A.D. 1820. The above described tract of land containing 414^{as} 66 perches And allowance of Six per cent for roads &c. Situated in Sadsbury Township Crawford County and at the time of making the same Solomon Englehaupt was residing there on, and there was built a house fit for the habitation of man and there appeared to be upwards of twenty acres of the land cleared, fenced and in a State of Cultivation.
