



Situate in Monroe (formerly Providence) township Bedford County containing 155 acres 149 perches & allowance of 6 per. Cent for roads &c. Being composed of two tract as follows; one containing 75 acres 110 perches & allowance, surveyed the 16th of August 1841, in pursuance of a warrant granted in the name of Jesse Deahl for 75 acres, dated the 12th of July - 1841, and resurveyed the 23rd of October 1852 in pursuance of an order of resurvey Granted by Board of Property to Jacob Barkman dated the 12th of July 1852. the other containing 80 acres 39 perches & allowance surveyed the 18th & 19th of May 1852 in pursuance of a warrant granted in the name of David Fletcher^{sr} for 76 acres dated the 13th of April 1839 connected for and to be patented to Jacob Barkman, Courses according to the true bearing
