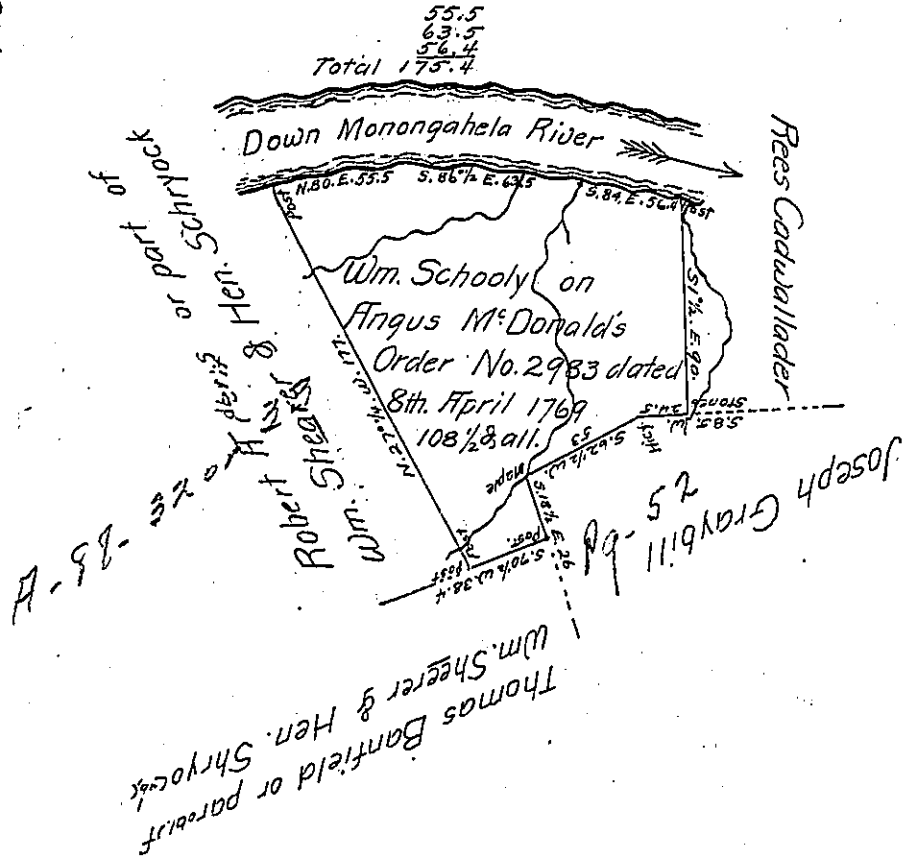


NB in Issuing the Certificate for Patent say N. 27 1/4 W. 177 ps. to a post on the Bank of said River.
