



Whereas an order on the Application of Joseph West No. 2043 Dated the first day of November 1769 for 30 acres of Land in West Nottingham Appears to have been regularly Executed by Benjamin Parvin then Deputy Surveyor not long after its date, The above draught is a Description of the same with a Small addition made thereto by Mr. Churchman The whole Contains Thirty two acres & twenty nine perches with the allowance of Six pCent for Roads &c. The land is now in the Possession of David Cope & has been so for Several Years past as I am informed and no objection exists that I know of to a return of Survey on the aforesaid Order in his name. I have examined the Draughts &c. relative to the same and expect they may be depended on. Certified this 10th day of April A.D. 1793. By
