Hugh McNairr Surveyed the land the 15th March 1788 and his Survey was Returned by me
the 20 May 1789 Containing 319 3/4 Acres have since found some of the lines rong measured
in that Draft & on the 11 October 1793 made a Careful resurvey of the whole & find
it to Contain but 300 1/4 Acres & wish the Land may be Pattered agreeable to this draft
