



A Draught of a tract of Land Situate in Fallowfield Township Washington County on the Monongahela River Called Sugar Narrows Containing one hundred thirty four Acres and one fourth of an Acre with Six Per Cent Allowance (obly) Surveyed May the 27th 1799 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to John Fenton for 134 Acres Dated March the 4th 1796.

By Virtue of a Warrant Granted to John Fenton dated the 4th of March 1796 the above described tract of Land Containing one hundred thirty four Acres & one fourth of an Acre & allowance of Six Per Cent for Roads Situate on the Monongahela River in Fallowfield Township Washington County Was Surveyed on the 27th day of May 1799 by Thomas Stokely Esquire late Deputy Surveyor And Examined and certified to be correct this 4th day of September 1802 by
