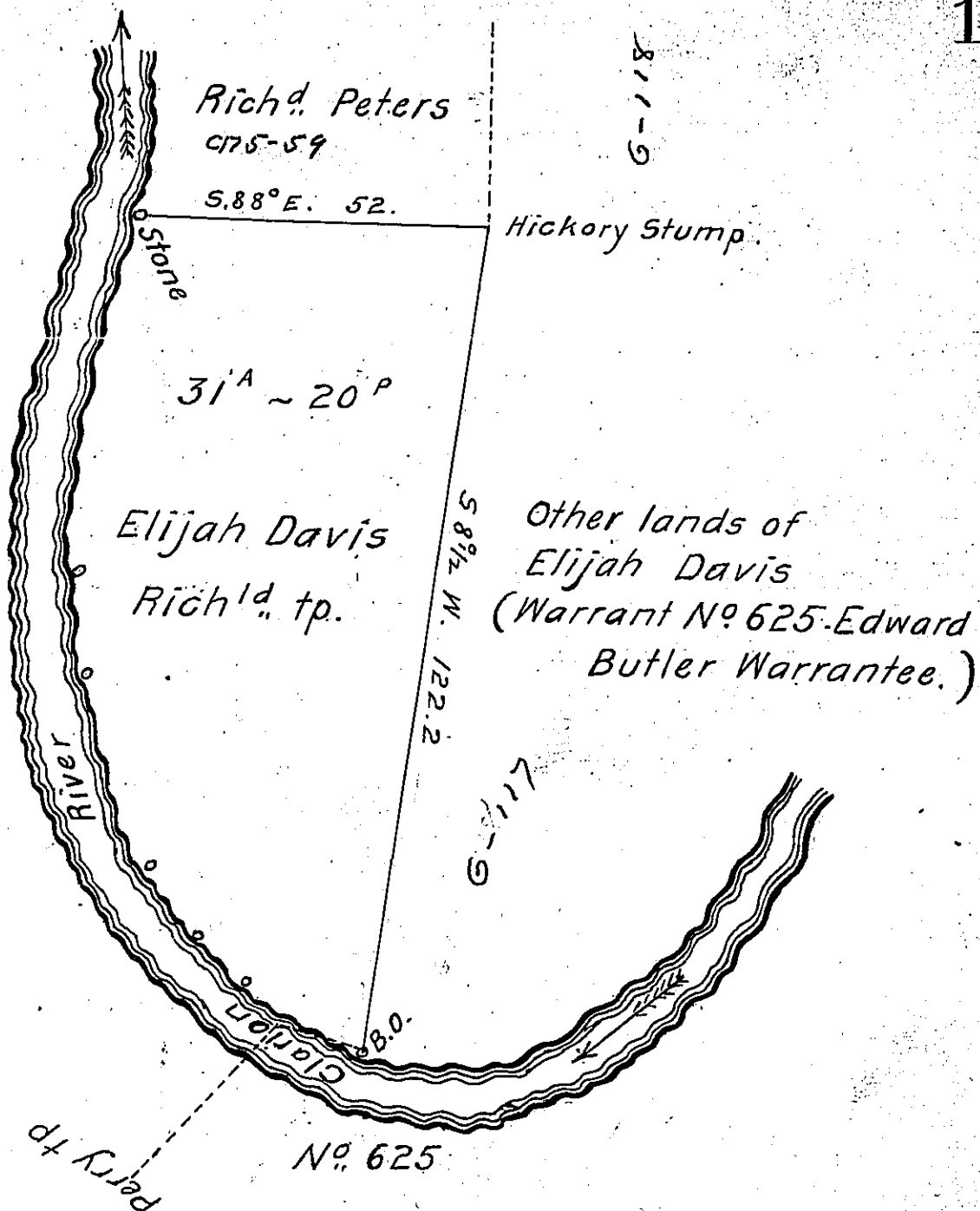


Courses and distances down Clarion River from the Black Oak Corner
