



The above is a Draught of a Survey made Feb. 28th 1839 for John Davidson Containing in all 307 Acres & 92 perches and Allo: of six per Cent. The part No. 1 is an original Survey made in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Hugh Davidson Dated Jan. 26th 1774 for 236 Acres but Contains 240 Acres 151 perches and Allow of six per Cent. The part No. 2 is part of an Original Survey made in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Hugh Davidson Dated Dec. 31st 1784 for 456 Acres Containing 66 Acres and 101 perches & Allowance of six per cent, The balance contains about 390 Acres and is owend by Ross, & Armstrong, and is unpatented situate in Plum Town- nship Allegheny County on the waters of Turtle Creek.
