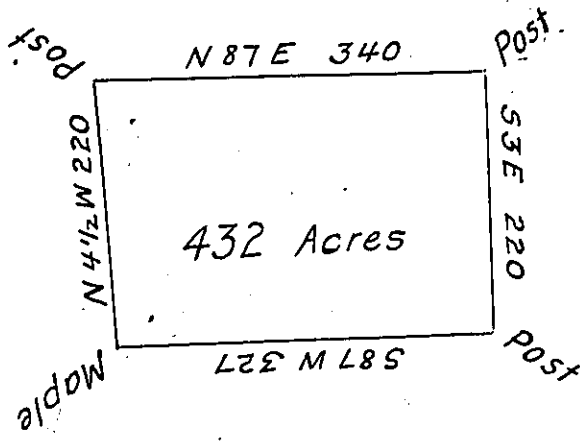

 of the Neshanock Branch of Beaver Creek in the second Donation  
 district in Alegheny County containing four hundred and thirty  
 two acres and allowance of six per Centum &c. Called Ambition
