Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tract of Land by Conrad Laub late D.S. under John Forsyth late D.S. on the 16th day of January A.D. 1787. And now at the request of the Present owner Bernard Feyser I am desired to make return of the draught as Calculated examined &c. the 30th day of June A.D. 1809.
