



Surveyed the above discribed tract of land agreeable to the old lines made by Henry Donnel Esquire on the 14th of June 1796. for ~~the~~ Alexander Mahan situated in Bald Eagle Township Lycoming County in the old purchase including Sugar run on the 16th of November 1826 in persuance of his warrent in the name of Cathreen Deabler dated the 27th of July 1792 containing four hundred and twenty two acres and thirty four perches & allowance of six per cent for roads
