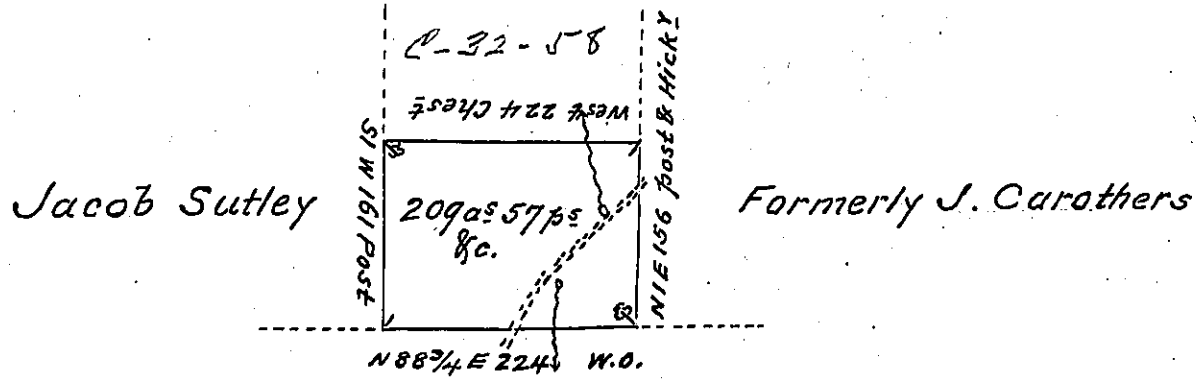


Sam! Beaty
