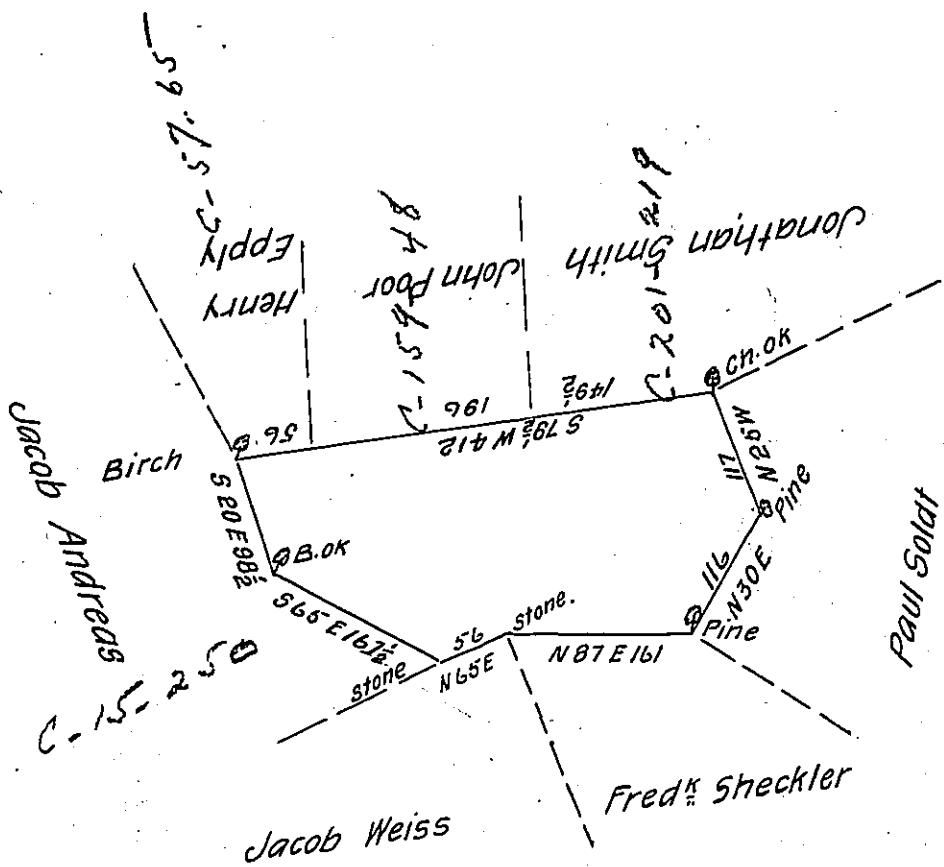


Penn Forest
