Surveyed for Isaac Degarmine for himself and other heirs of Jacob Soyler the 29th day of October 1869 being a part of a larger tract of four hundred Acres and allowance. Originally Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Fredrick Flinchbaugh and Adam Flinchbaugh dated the 8th day of May 1794.
