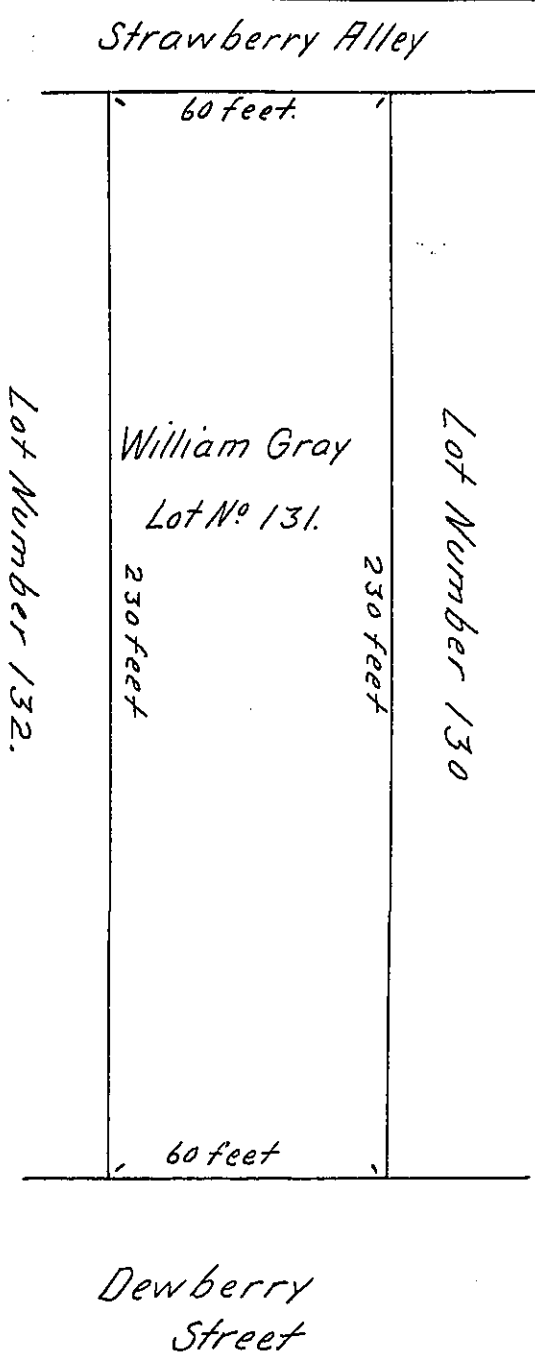

In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3<sup>d</sup> day of July 1772 on a Certain Lot of Ground Situate in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town Number One Hundred and Thirty One Containing in Breadth East and West on North side of Dewberry Street Sixty feet and in Length North and South Two Hundred and thirty feet Bounded Southward by Dewberry Street Eastward by Lot Number One Hundred and thirty Northw<sup>d</sup> by Strawberry Alley and Westward by Lot Number One Hundred and Thirty Two Returned into the Secretary's Office the 13<sup>th</sup> day of April 1775 for William Gray.
