



In Pursuance of an Order from the Secretary, there was Surveyed for Edward Biddle and Collinson Read Esqrs. Church Wardens of the Episcopal Church at Reading in Behalf of Henry Gossler a Certain Lot of Ground Situate in the Town of Reading in the County of Berks marked in General Plan of Said Town Number Three Hundred and Ninety Six Containing in Breadth North and South on Callowhill Street Sixty feet and in Length East and West Two Hundred and Thirty feet Bounded Westward by Callowhill Street Southward by Lot No 397 Eastward by a Twenty feet Alley and Northward by Lot No 393. Returned into the Secretarys Office the 25<sup>th</sup> day of May 1776. for said Henry Gossler
