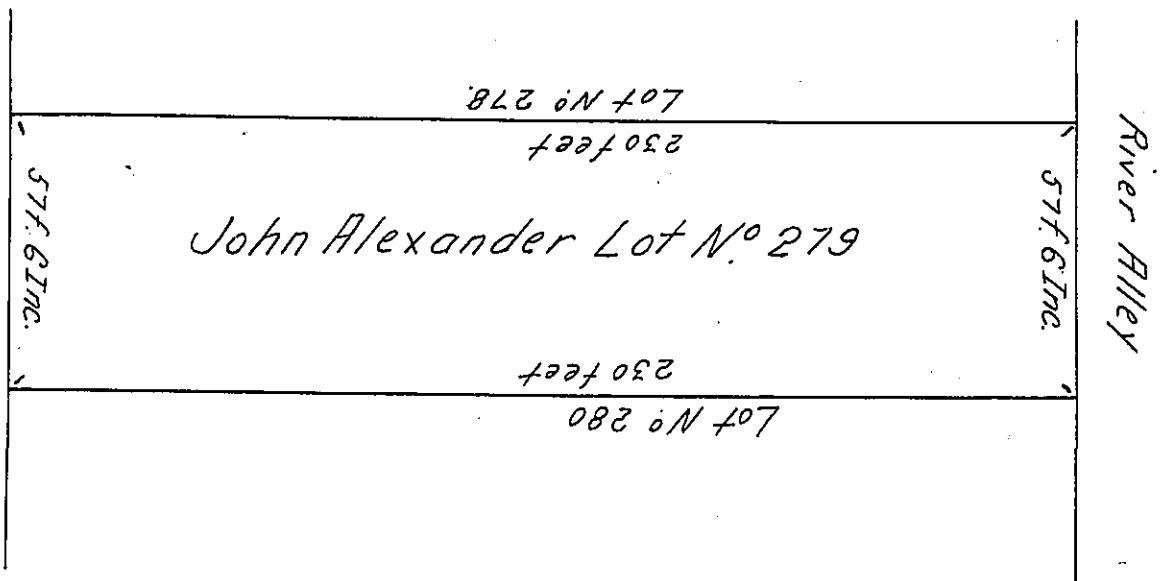


Susquehanna River

Broad Way



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3<sup>d</sup> day of July following for John Alexander on a Certain Lot of Ground in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a General plan of said Town Number Two hundred and Seventy Nine. Containing in Breadth North and South on Broad Way fifty Seven feet Six Inches and in Length East and West Two hundred and thirty feet Bounded Westward by Broad Way aforesaid Southward by Lot Number Two hundred and Eighty Eastward by River Alley and Northward by Lot Number Two hundred and Seventy Eight Returned into the Secretarys Office the 26<sup>th</sup> day of October 1774 for Christopher Gatties by Warr.<sup>t</sup> dated the 25<sup>th</sup> Instant.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this fourth day of November 1904.
