



A Draught of two hundred and Sixty five Acres and twelve perches and allowance of 6 p. Cent Surveyed for John Schucher Situate at Tulpehaccon in Berks County being part of a Strip of Land cut off from the Honble. Richard Penn's Manor and marked in a General Plan of the same No. 15.

Returned into the Secretary's Office the 4th day of December 1771 by Warrant dated the 2^d December 1771 granted to George Gebheart.
