



A Plan of a Lot of Ground in the Town of York N^o 39. situate on the North side of High Street containing in Breadth on the said High Street Sixty five Feet & in length to a twenty feet Alley two hundred and thirty feet. bounded Southward with High Street, Westward with a Lot of Ground now in the tenure of Joseph Welshantz N^o 40. Northward with a twenty feet Alley and Eastward with a Lot N^o 38. Entered on the Plan of the said Town and survey'd for John Guitinger who has built an House on the same Lot according to the Conditions of settling the Town. Certified at York the 15th day of February 1753.
