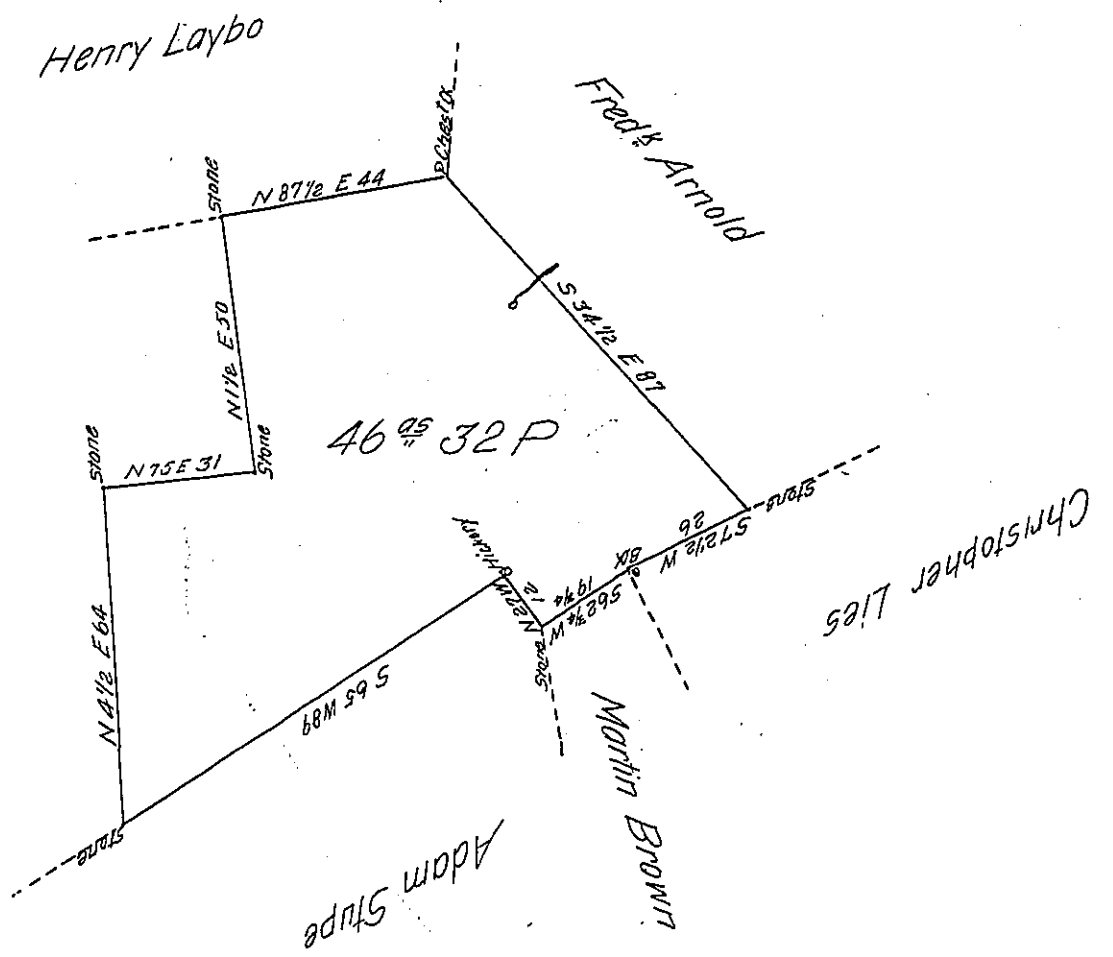

 and thirty two Perches and the allowance of Six Per Cent for Roads.
