In pursuance of a Warrant dated 22<sup>d</sup> Nov 1793 by John Wells Esq late D.S. Certified & Returned this 14<sup>th</sup> day of Aug<sup>t</sup> 1828, In Pursuance of two Warrants; one Granted to Thomas Faith for 60 Acres dated 22<sup>d</sup> Nov. 1793, the other to Daniel Horner for 40<sup>a</sup> dated 19<sup>th</sup> March A.D. 1813.
