



Draft of a tract of land situate, formerly in Maxetawny township, now part in Longswamp township Berks County and part in Macungy township Lehigh County, Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant, dated the first day of July A.D. 1756 granted to Jacob Finstermacher. Containing Eighty five acres, twenty two perches, and allowance of six P.Ct for roads &c. as appears from the works of James Scull late a Deputy Surveyor, the original whereof remains filed in the Deputy Surveyor's Office of Berks County. September 19<sup>th</sup> 1827.
