



Situate in Hemlock Township Columbia County Surveyed originally to wit on the 20th day of September 1784 unto Henry Funck by Virtue of his warrant bearing date the 16th day of July 1784 by William Montgomery deputy Surveyor and Containing 409 & 142^{ps} & allowance and now to wit on the 16th day of January 1828 by Virtue of an Order from the Board of Property of the State of Pennsylvania to Resurvey the same and correct Errors and Exclude interferences dated January the 4th 1828 Resurveyed the same for the Heirs of Gabriel Hiester Decd agreeably to the old lines and find the same to Contain two Hundred Acres and one hundred and thirty two perches and the usual Allowance of Six per Cent for Roads &c exclusive of interferences.
