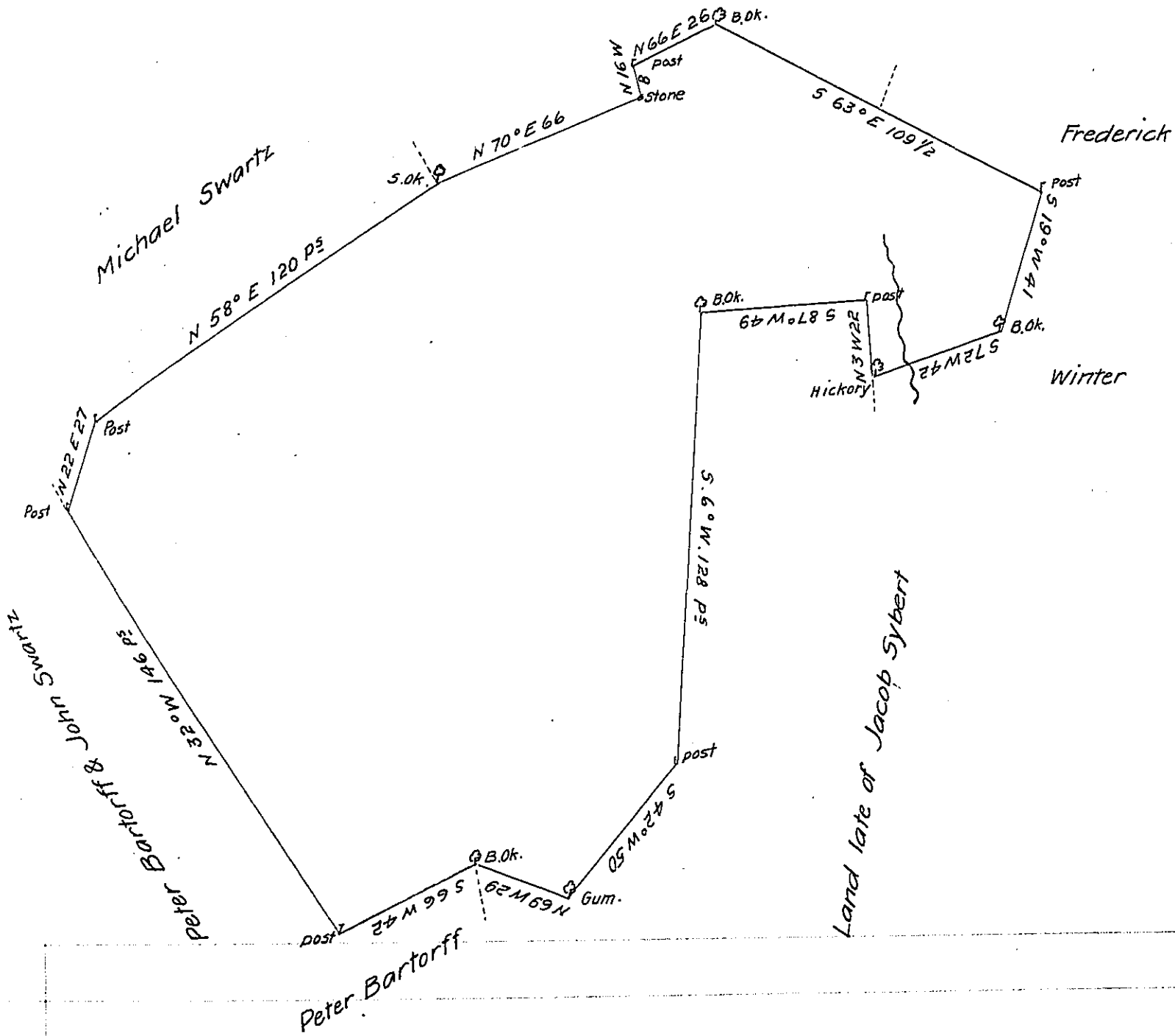


Wendle Keabler
