



A draught of a tract of land situate in Washington Township Franklin County containing forty nine acres and one hundred and ten perches and the usual allowance of six P. Cent for roads &c. being part of a larger tract of one hundred and twenty six acres and fifty six perches and allowance &c. which was formerly surveyed in pursuance of two Orders of Survey granted George Robb, bearing dates December 30<sup>th</sup> 1766 No 2295 and December 5<sup>th</sup> 1767 No 4638. Resurveyed and laid off from the other part of the tract for John Esich Nov<sup>r</sup> 17<sup>th</sup> 1812.
