



A draught of eighty five acres and one hundred and thirty four perches of land with six per cent for roads situate in Derry township in Mifflin formerly Cumberland, county, which is part of a tract said to contain 186<sup>8</sup>/<sub>8</sub> acres surveyed 8<sup>th</sup> April 1772 in pursuance of an order to Robert Glenn dated 4<sup>th</sup> November 1766 No. 1785, which appears to have been divided 18<sup>th</sup> Nov<sup>r</sup>. 1795 — Examined 28<sup>th</sup> Feby 1812.
