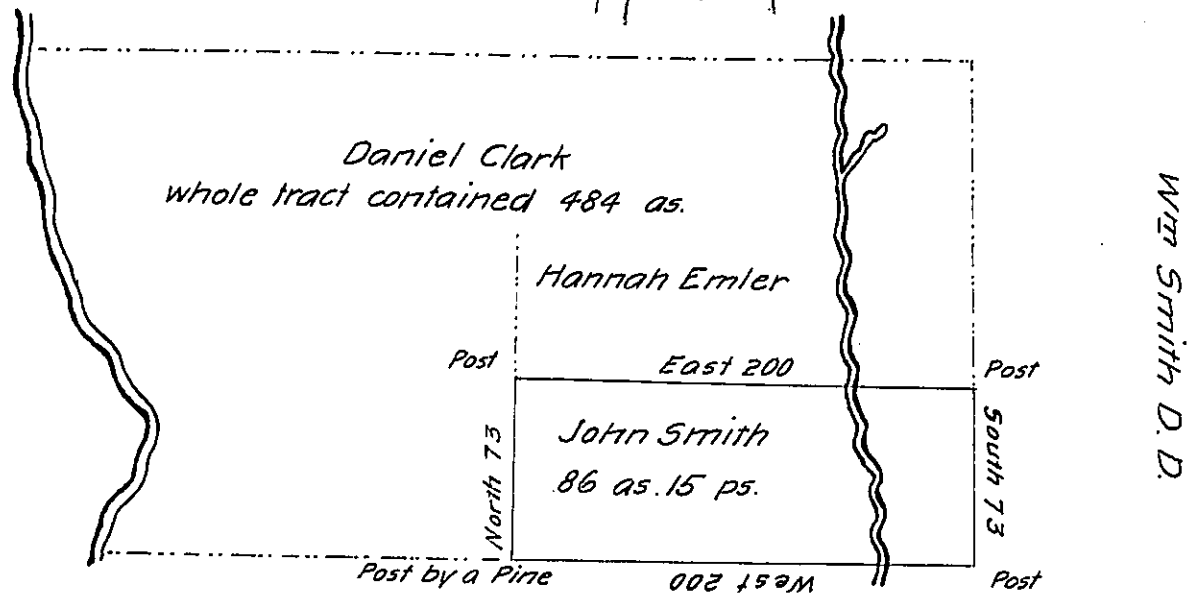

Situate in Union township Bedford county containing 86 acres 15 perches and allowance of 6 per cent for roads &c. Surveyed for John Smith the 10<sup>th</sup> of January 1810 by Thomas Vickroy. Being part of a tract that originally contained 484 acres and allowance. Surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted in the name of Daniel Clark dated the 1st of June 1763. Examined, copied & returned the 6<sup>th</sup> of December 1851. (To be patented to John Smith)
