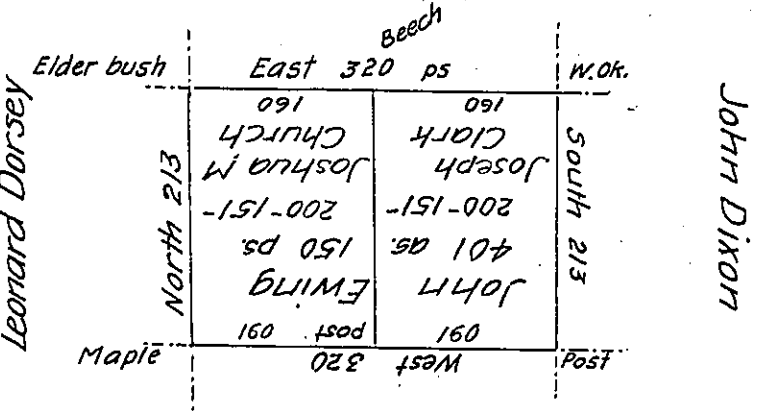

District-Line

Situate on the west side of French creek in Allegheny County containing 401 acres 150 perches & allowance of 6 per cent for roads & surveyed the 13th July 1799. In pursuance of a warrant for 400 a^s granted to John Ewing bearing date the 30th May 1792. It being the same tract of land which was surveyed the 6th Nov^r 1794 for Isaac Jones on his improvement dated 5th November 1794
Crawford County 55.

I do certify that the above is a true copy of Survey as it stands stated of Record remaining in my office now situate in Mercer County in Sandy creek township, in Powers District except the line of division which was surveyed & marked between Joshua M. Church & Joseph Clark the 4th July 1817
