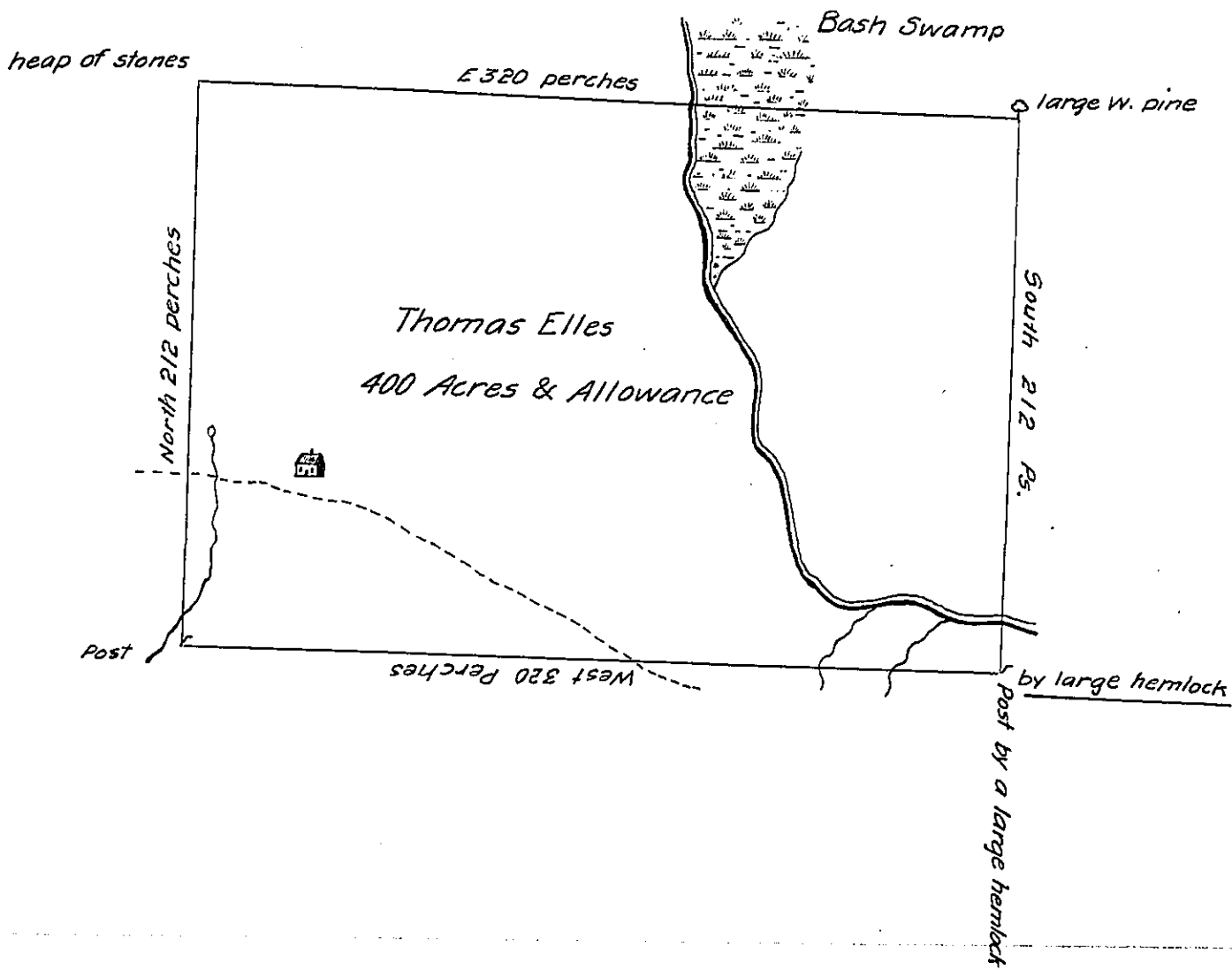


Scale 80 perches to inch
