



Draught of a tract of land situate in Fannet Township Franklin County, containing one hundred & fifty three acres, one hundred and thirty six perches & allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Surveyed 28 October 1829 in pursu-  
 ance of a contract with the Board of Property for carrying into effect the several  
 Acts of Assembly for relating to unpatented lands under Proprietary rights &c  
 And by virtue of an order of survey dated 2<sup>nd</sup> July 1767 No 4113 granted to  
 James Montgomery for 300 acres "joining Samuel Maris Tuscarora Mountain  
 and land in dispute between Thomas Askey & David Campbell in Fannet  
 Township" - Resurveyed agreeable to lines survey<sup>d</sup> for said Montgomery 29-  
 March 1769

Note An order of survey dated 3<sup>d</sup> February 1768 No 4736 was granted to Robert  
 Culbertson for 250 acres "joining Andw Douglas & Tuscarora Mountain in Fannet  
 Township; appears to have been intended for the above land but no evidence ap-  
 pears of ownership in said Culbertson.
