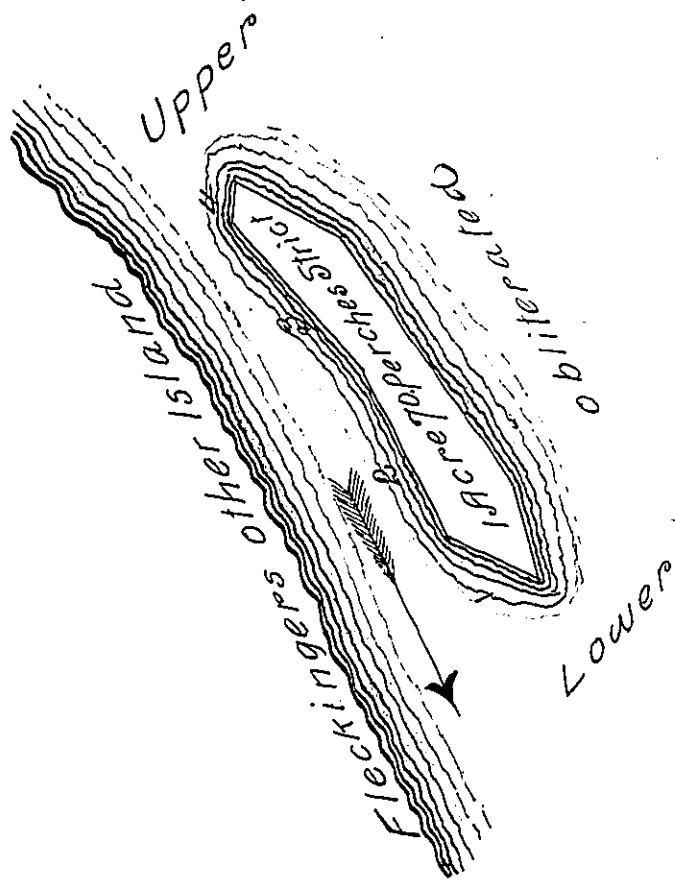

-kingers Island. Situate in Swatara Township Dauphin
County Containing one Acre Seventy perches strict meas-
ure by his Warrant dated the 27th day of July 1814
