



In pursuance of a Warrant granted to John Fultz Bearing date the 16<sup>th</sup> day of March 1812 Surveyed on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of December Following the above described Tract of land containing one hundred and three acres and twenty nine perches of allowance proportioned at six per cent for roads &c. including a dwelling house & Barn & about twelve acres of land cleared & fenced together with his other improvements <sup>thereon</sup> first commenced in 1807 Situate on the Chesnut ridge in Donegall Township in the County of Westmoreland
