



In pursuance of a Warrant for 400 acres of Land dated the 5th day of July 1814 was Surveyed October the 5th 1814 for James Fetterman the above described tract of Land containing Four hundred three acres one hundred twenty four perches and allowance of Six per Cent for Roads &c. situate on the Waters of Big Coniaut in Beaver Township Crawford County Pa. and at the time of making said Survey James McDowel Junr. was living on the same with ^{his} family under the name of the said James Fetterman and there appeared to be upwards of twenty acres cleared fenced and in a good state of Cultivation
