(directed to be surveyed in three pieces or surreys) And now at the request of the owner Michael Ziegler the above has been Calculated examined and found to be correct the 6th day of June A.D. 1811 and at his request Returned for Confirmation To Andrew Porter Esq^r per Jacob Spangler D.S. Surveyor General Lancaster Pa.
