



A Draught of a Tract of Land situate on a Run emptying itself into Dunning's Creek about three Miles from the Mouth, and six from Bedford, in the County of Cumberland containing Three hundred and thirty eight Acres and a quarter and the usual allowance of six acres 6. Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the ninth day of May 1765 to John Feit in pursuance of a Warrant dated the thirty-first day of May 1762.
