



In pursuance of a warrant Bearing Date the twenty fifth day of April 1811, surveyed unto Robert Foster on the 4th of June following the above discribed tract of Land Containing Eighty six acres and eighty seven and one half perches, ^{and allowance of six $\frac{1}{4}$ Cent.} situate on white thorn run, in Salem township and County of Westmoreland including an improvement thereon commenced in April 1783.
