



In pursuance of a Warrant for 400 acres dated the 21<sup>st</sup> of April 1794 granted to John Garvin was Surveyed on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of December 1817 the above described tract of land containing three hundred and ninety two acres and twenty seven perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Situate in Cassewago township Crawford County and at the time of making the same Cornelius M<sup>c</sup>Bride was residing thereon and had a house fit for the habitation of man and eight acres of land cleared fenced and in cultivation
