



Situate formerly in Monaghan now Franklin township in the County of York Containing within the black lines as above set forth 49^{as} 10^{ps} and allowance Being part of a larger tract of 148^{as} 12^{ps} & allowance which was originally Surveyed by Charles Lukens late D.D. on the 11th day of March 1775 in pursuance of a Warrant for 50^{as} granted to Casper Grubb bearing date the 9th day of February 1773. Resurveyed and Divided off from the said larger tract of Land the 22^d Day of May 1816 and now this 5th day of April 1825 the same has been calculated examined and found correct and at the request of Abraham Kaufman the present owner the same is returned for confirmation
