Situate in Halifax township Dauphin County Containing Sixty one acres eighty perches and allowance of Six per Cent. Gabriel Hiester Esq<sup>r</sup> }

 Note. the above tract of Land had been originally Surveyed to Mary Scott by application N<sup>o</sup> 4128 dated 26 August 1769. But on a hearing before the board of Property on Caveat 23 November 1773 the same was allowed to John Gilmore.
