



In pursuance of a Warrant for 400 acres dated the 12th day of April A.D. 1794 was surveyed for Philip Grassey the 30th day of January 1817 the above Discribed tract of Land containing 415 acres 128 perches and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c and that the same was devided as above stated Between James Freeman and Joseph Clark (as above stated) for the purpose of ubtaining seperate patents from the land office and at the time of making said survey, James Payne was in posesion of the same under the said James freeman and there appered to be upwards of 10 acres of the land Cleared and fenced & a house fit for the habitation of man and that the same is situate in venang Township Craw-ford County Pa
