Draught of one hundred and Fifty four Acres and seventy one perches Situated in Turbett Township Mifflin County (Formerly Lack Township Cumberland County) being part of 296 acres appears to have been surveyed 17<sup>th</sup> May 1766 by virtue of three warrants one to Geo Armstrong dated 3<sup>rd</sup> Feb<sup>y</sup>. 1765 & two <sup>W<sup>ts</sup></sup> to W<sup>m</sup>. Graham each Dated 2<sup>nd</sup> March 1763 resurveyed and Divided at the instance of John Patterson Esq<sup>r</sup>. 22<sup>nd</sup> February 1822.

Note, the original survey is said to contain 419 1/4 acres but since part thereof appropriated to John Fitzgerald W<sup>t</sup>. dated 11<sup>th</sup> Jan<sup>y</sup>. 1765 as above represented and only 296 acres.
