In pursuance of a Warrant for 400<sup>ac</sup> dated the 21<sup>th</sup> day of April A.D. 1794 was Surveyed the 27<sup>th</sup> day of January 1817 for Philip Grans the above discribed Tract of Land containing 425<sup>ac</sup> 27 perches & Allowance of six per Cent for Roads. &c and that the same was devided as above stated. Between Phinehas Dunham & Joseph Clark the assignees of the said Philip Grans for the purpose of obtaining Seperate patents & at the time of making said survey Elias Cole was in the posesion of the same as tenant under the aforesaid Phinehas Dunham he had a house fit for the habitation of man and there appered to be upwards of twelve acres Cleared & fenced & the same is situate in Venan-  
-go Township Crawford County Pa.
