



In Pursuance of a warrant for 400 acres dated the 21th of April A.D. 1794 was surveyed for Charles Grasey the 30th day of January 1817 the above discribed tract of Land Contain-
 -ing 418 acres 54 perches and allowance of six per cent for
 Roads. &c. and that the same was devided as above stated
 between Pherihos Dunham and Joseph Clark for the purpose
 of obtaining seperate patents from the land office and at the
 time of making said survey James Pane Junr. was in the
 possession of the same tenant under said Ph^s Dunham
 and there appered to be upwards of 12 acres Cleared &
 fenced and a convenient house fit for the habitation of
 man and that the same is situate in Venango Township
