



A Draught of an Island situate in the river Susquehanna in the township of Manor and County of Lancaster called Duck Island Lying on the east side of Gordons Island Opposite to land of Isaac Lightner on the Lancaster side about two hundred yards from the line of Hempfield township containing fifty three perches strict measure Surveyed in pursuance of a warrant dated the 13th day of April Anno Domini 1825 granted to Thomas Groom &c January 3^d 1828
